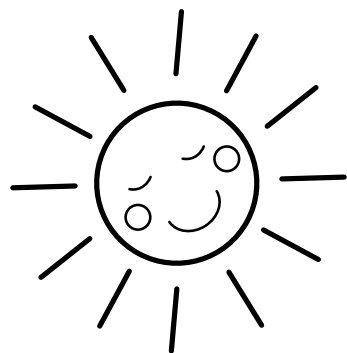
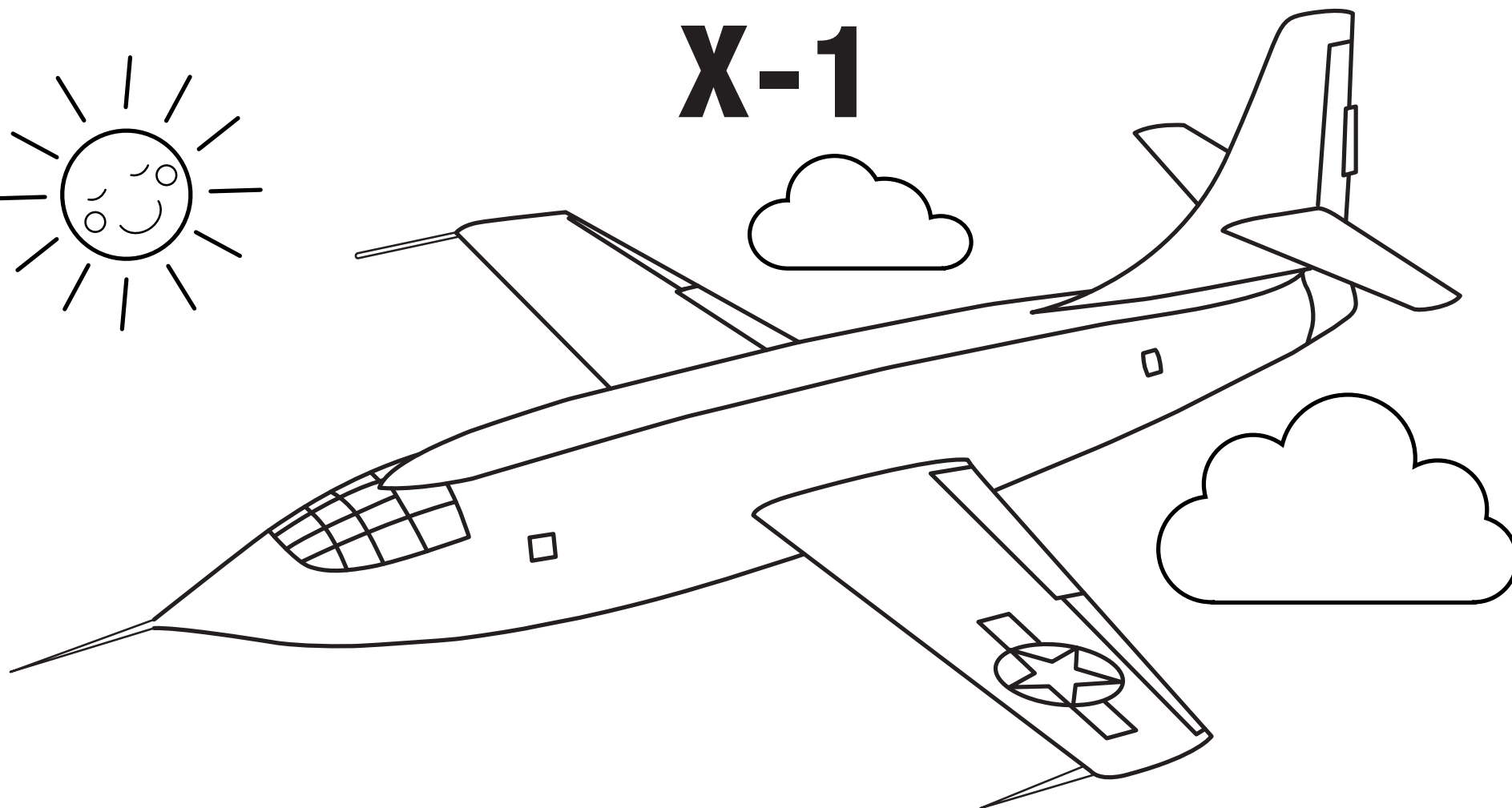




X-1
