7th child of John WATTS & Ann Nancy AVERY

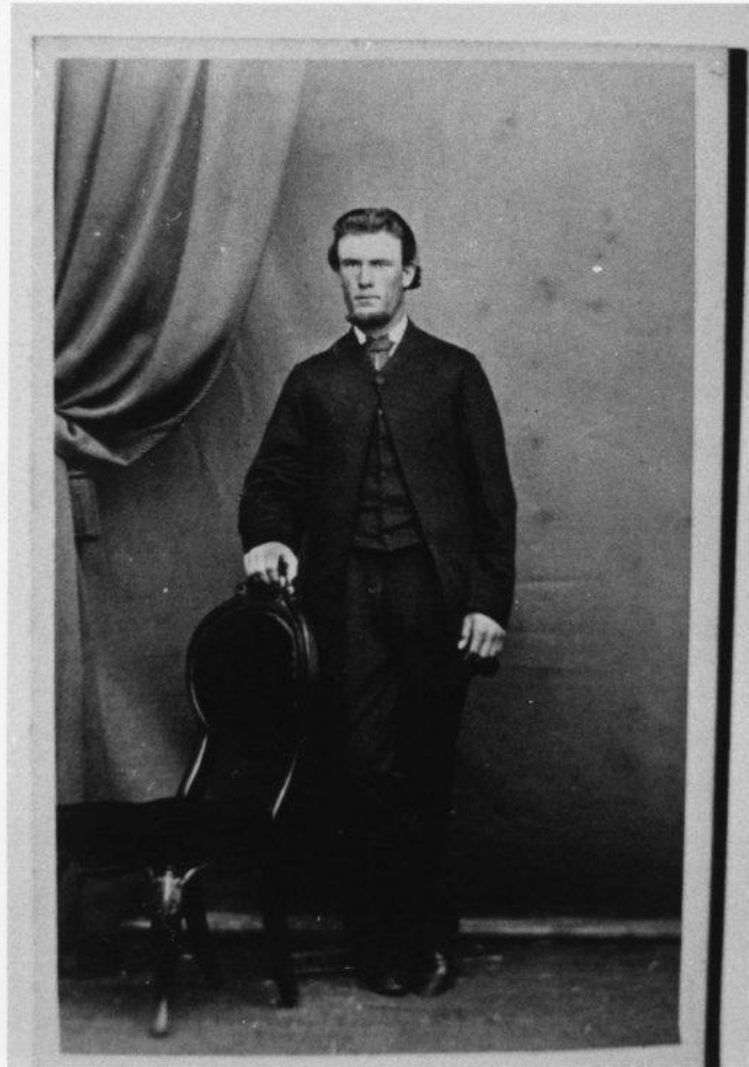
born 1848 at Hindmarshtown
